# VTCT Level 2 NVQ Award in Make-Up

#### Who is this course for?

This course suits the qualified therapist or beginner wishing to learn about the application of make up to different skin types and conditions. You will learn how to plan and apply make up for several occasions and how to disguise minor imperfections. You will also learn the art of applying false lashes and for this purpose you will need to have a glue test prior to the start of the course.

### What does the course will cover?

- Hygiene, Health & Safety
- Client care & communication
- Anatomy & Physiology of Face and Skull
- Equipment and Products
- Preparation of treatment room, trolley and client
- Contra-indications and Contra-actions
- Skin Types, correction techniques
- Client Consultation
- Cleansing, Toning and Moisturising, Exfoliation
- Effects of lighting on makeup application
- Make up plans
- Full make routine for Day, Evening & a special occasion
- False Lash application
- The importance of selling products to the client
- Aftercare / Homecare Advice

All products and tools are provided for the training days at the centre when you attend. No kit is required to complete the training days, nor included in the course fee; however is it advisable to purchase a kit for your home practical use (case studies). Please speak to your training coordinator who can assist you.

### **Entry Requirements:**

You will need to be 18+ years old. You will need to complete the VTCT (ITEC) Level 2 award in Infection Prevention (COVID-19) for Make-up Services. This can be completed at home at your leisure but there is a small exam to be completed at the centre. This course is free when you register for your qualification but certification is £20. You will also need a good understanding of English to complete your assignments and exam.

#### Course structure:

The theory is completed as home-study, with live zoom sessions, and assignments making this an ideal route for those who wish to study flexibly around other commitments. This will need to be completed before attending your practical training days. Once you have completed all training and coursework, we will arrange for you to attend a multiple choice exam and practical assessment day to achieve your VTCT qualification.

### **Course Duration:**

You will need to complete your home study and assignments before attending your practical sessions (2-4 sessions) which will include demonstrations and guidance. You will need to do 5-10 case studies and return for your practical assessment and multiple choice exam. It is advisable to bring a camera with you to take before and after photos.

## What will I receive when I complete the course?

Once you have successfully completed the course you will receive a VTCT recognised qualification. This will enable you to obtain public liability insurance.
